Adverse Drug Reactions are a common cause of morbidity and mortality in patients. To increase awareness about the same and increase reporting of adverse drug reactions, the Government of India has made a Pharmacovigilance Programme of India (PvPI). Department of Pharmacology in Maulana Azad Medical College has been made a center for monitoring of adverse drug reactions. The Medical Council of India also requires all Medical Colleges to have a college Pharmacovigilance Committee.

The purpose of the College Pharmacovigilance Committee in Maulana Azad Medical College is to -

- 1. Oversee safe use of medicines in the hospitals attached to MAMC.
